

The Bob Hughes Bass Trombone Competition 2016

Rules and Conditions

- Candidates must be 23 or under on 20th November 2016 to be eligible to participate in the competition.
- Candidates must submit an unedited MP3 or CD performance no later than 1 October 2016
- Audio files must arrive with the BTS Secretary, Alison Keep (D'Arcy Gate, Kelvedon Road, Tolleshunt D'Arcy, Essex, CM9 8EL): secretary@britishtrombonesociety.org, with your name, date of birth, title of own choice piece and a very brief biography.
- In order to maintain impartiality, audio files must not include the name(s) of the performer(s) or any other identifying items.
- The competition judges will be eminent professional bass trombonists.
- Three finalists will be invited to play the same programme at the final competition; therefore, candidates must be free to perform at Oundle School, near Peterborough, on the day of the final round, Sunday 20th November, 2016. A piano accompanist will be available at the final, to take place during the BTS East Anglia Trombone Day, or you may bring your own accompanist.
- The judges' decision will be final and binding. The audio files will remain the property of the BTS.
